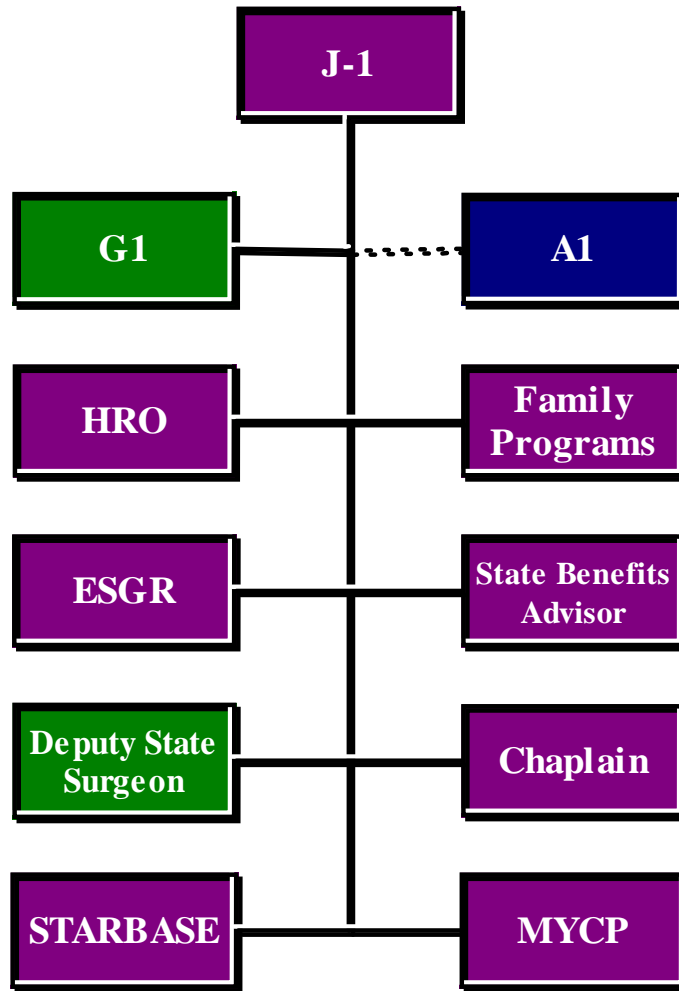


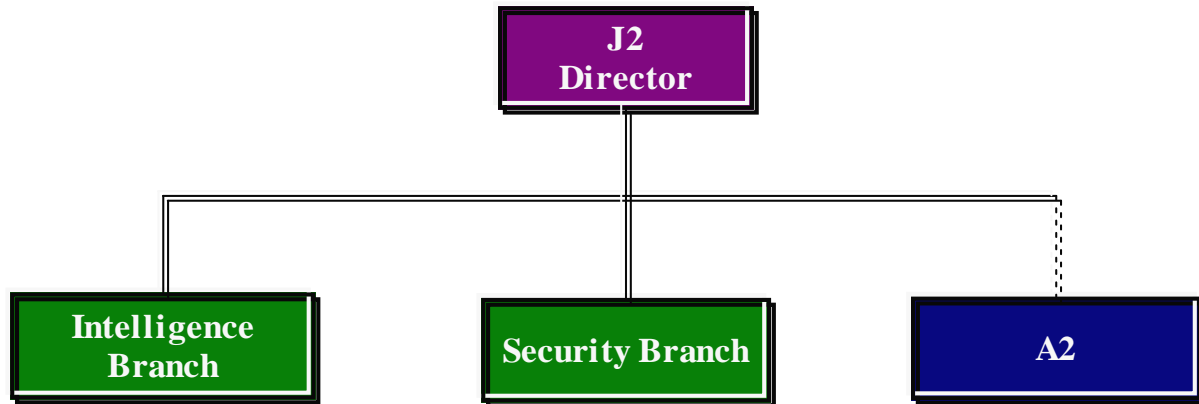


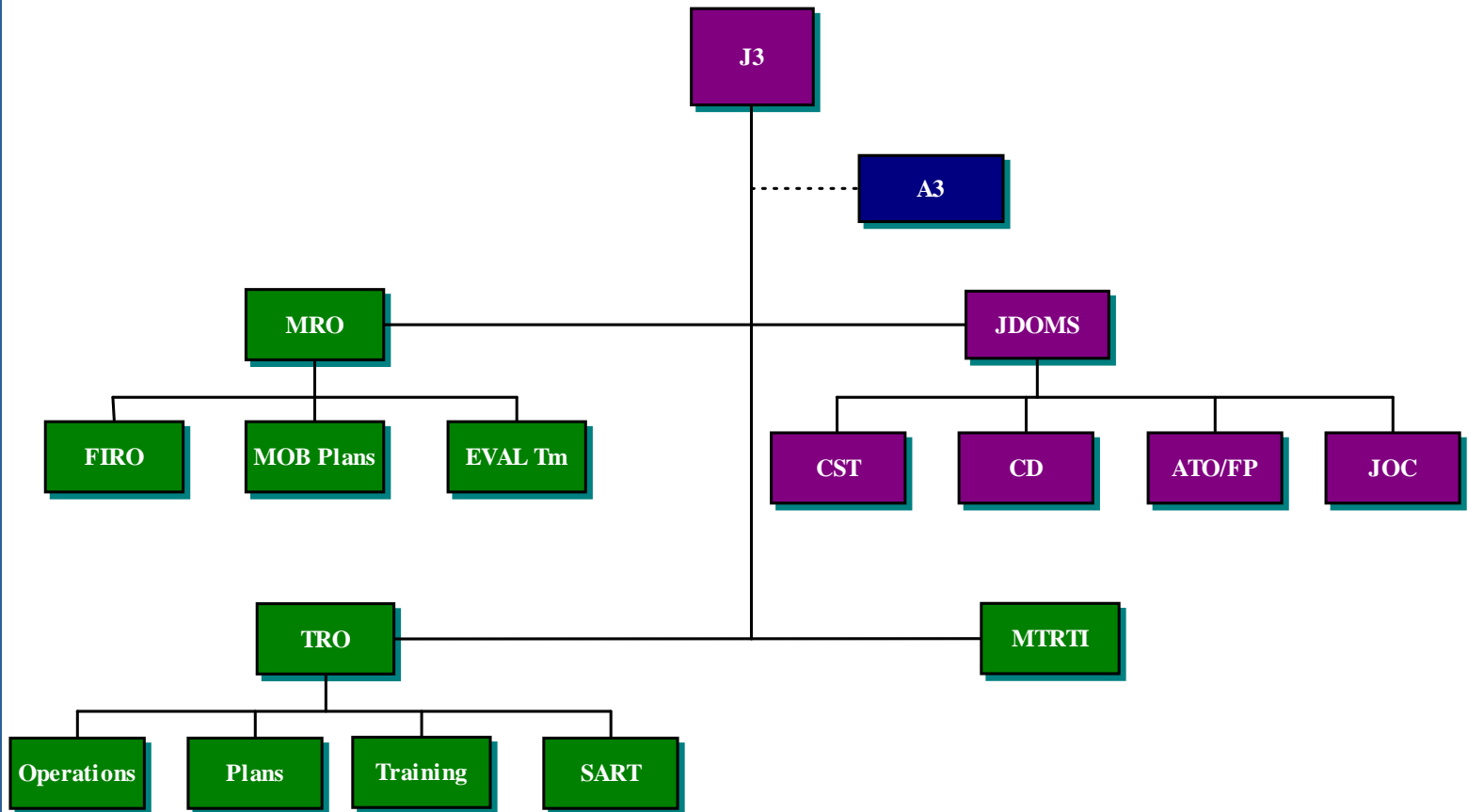
Joint Force Headquarters State (JFHQ-MT) Mission Statement

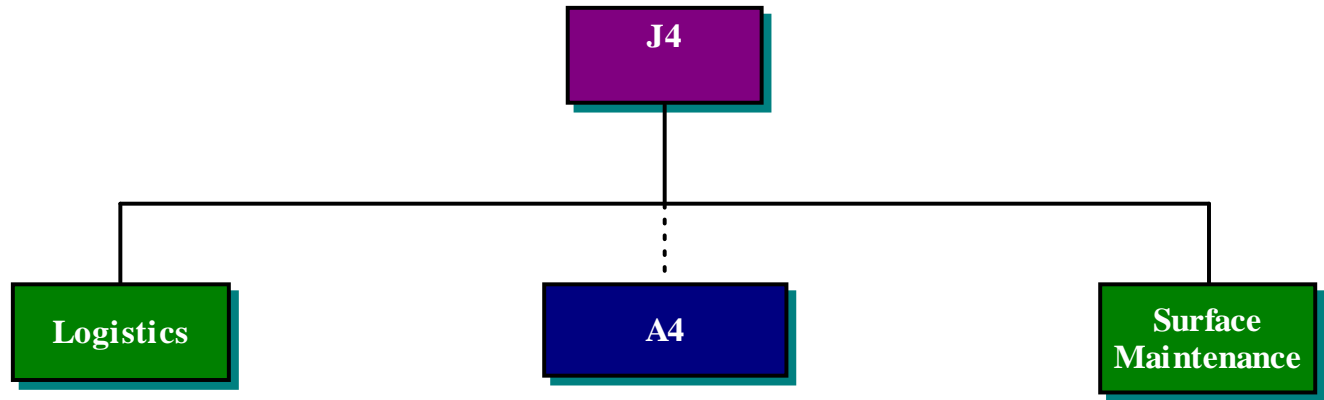
The JFHQ-MT maintains trained and equipped forces as reserve components of the Army and Air Force and performs missions as directed by state or Federal authorities. The JFHQ-MT supports command and control of all assigned Army and Air National Guard forces. In accordance with policies and procedures established by the Secretary of the Army and the Secretary of the Air Force, the JFHQ-MT will exercise command and control of Homeland Defense, Defense Support to Civil Authorities, and/or other domestic emergency missions in a State Active Duty, title 32 or title 10 status. In addition, the JFHQ-MT provides expertise and situational awareness to DoD authorities to facilitate integration of federal and state activities.

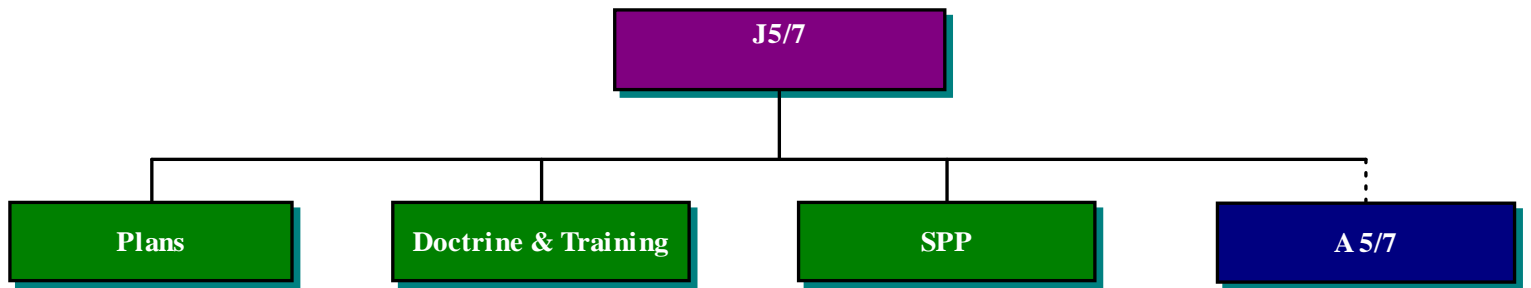


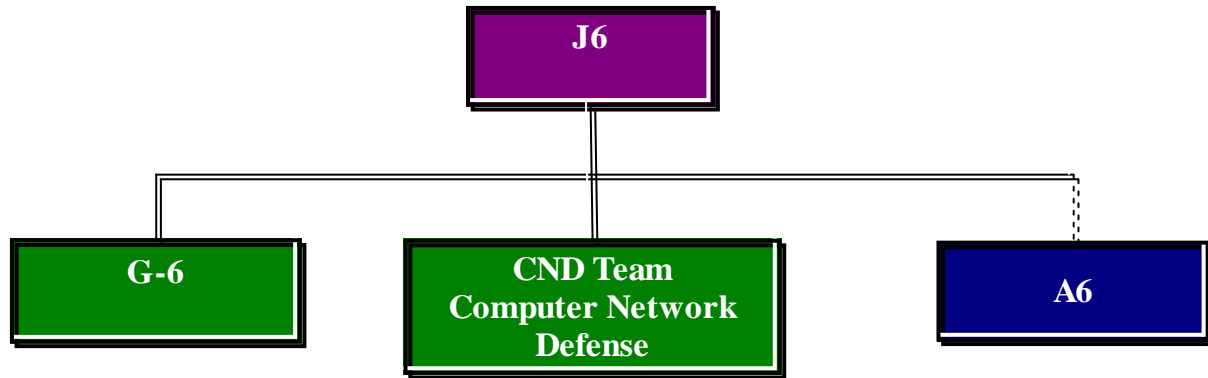


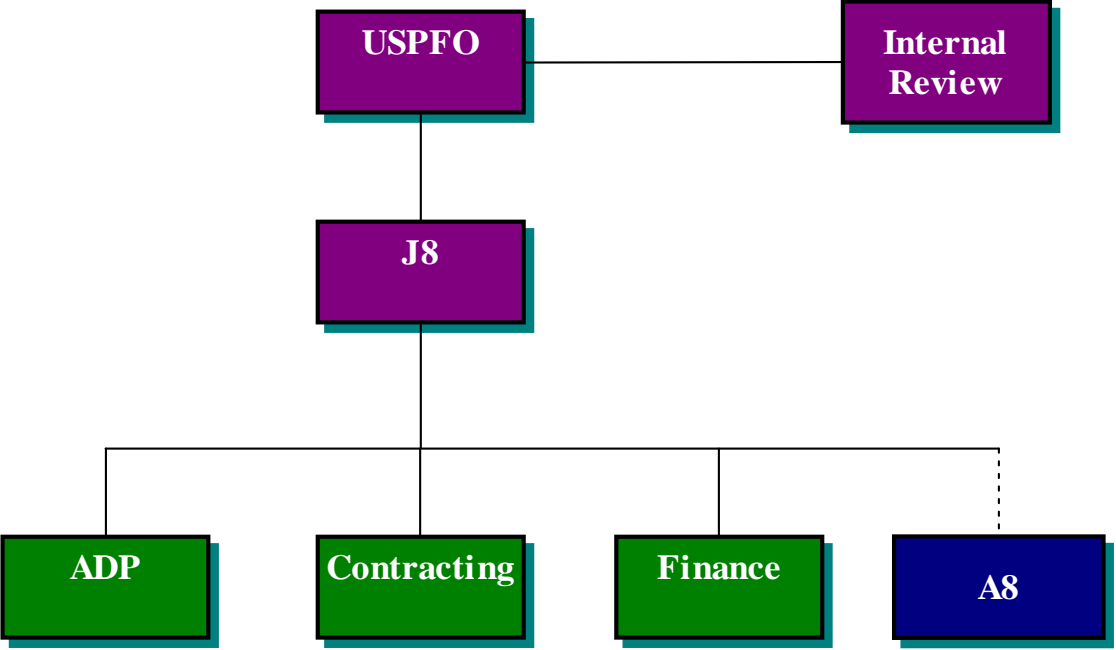
