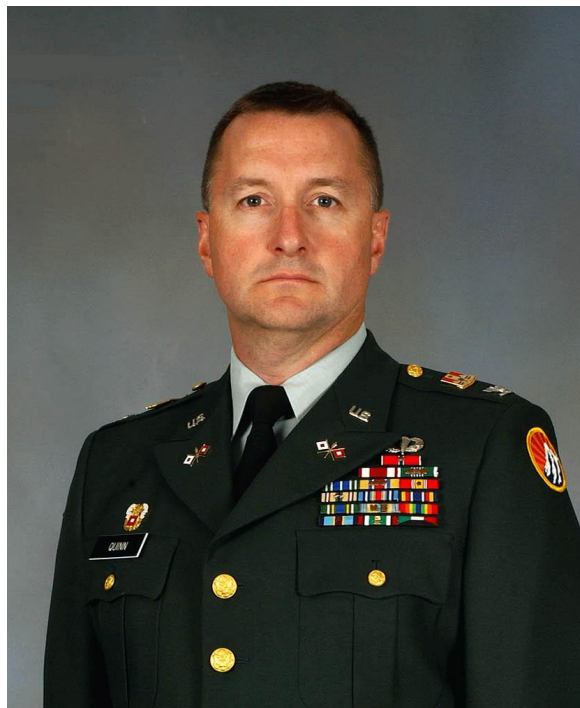


COLONEL MATTHEW T. QUINN

Colonel Matthew T. Quinn is the Commander for 95th Troop Command, Montana Army National Guard. He is responsible to the Chief of the Joint Staff and the Adjutant General to provide qualified Army National Guard staff functions to support the forces ready to deploy in support of national defense, homeland defense, or military support to civil authority. Additionally, he is responsible for the administration, logistical and training functions of four diverse battalions and four separate units within the Montana Army National Guard. He is also responsible for ensuring the Soldiers of the command meet readiness standards, are trained and equipped, and are capable of mobilizing and fulfilling their wartime as well as State missions.
