This congressionally directed medical research project will be a landmark study of the bereavement process and experience of loss for surviving military families.

The goals of this study are to understand the unique circumstances that lead to risks and resilience in children and families following a military death.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THIS STUDY?

FAMILIES OF SERVICE MEMBERS who have died by **ANY** circumstance of death in **ACTIVE DUTY STATUS** in the United States Military (Active, Guard and Reserve Components of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard) on or after *September 11, 2001*, including:

- Parents (adoptive, biological, custodial)/Step-Parents
- Spouses/Ex-Spouses/Adult Partners
- Children/Adult Children
- Siblings/Step-Siblings
