5. Cultural History of Montana

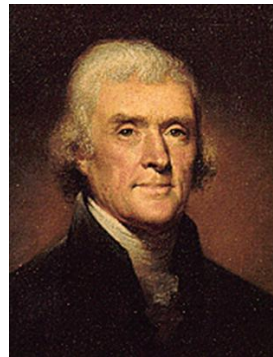
Though sometimes forgotten, the Lewis and Clark expedition was a military expedition.

THE EXPEDITION

The Lewis and Clark expedition to explore the American West was the space program of its day...Fascinating, expensive, and filled with possibilities, danger and adventure. Much survived the expedition—notes, maps, samples, drawings, and journals—but little is now available for viewing and handling.

The solution was to create Discovery Boxes filled with replicas of the same items for students to touch and ponder. These boxes serve as a wonderful tool to educate students and provide them with a tangible hands-on approach to learning history.

Many of the replicas show Lewis and Clark's interaction with the Native Americans they met during their journey and how they related to each other by showing mutual respect, displaying integrity, and honoring each other with gifts.
