REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR Fire Inspector I training, Fort Harrison, MT

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; quotes are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The NAICS code is 611430 and size standard is less than \$7.0 Million. The incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular 2005-26, Effective 1 June 2008 & Class Deviation 2005-00001. Offers shall propose a fixed price for entry level fire inspector training at Fort Harrison, MT from 14 JUN 10 to 18 JUN 10.

A. Entry-level fire inspector training for up to 25 students at Fort Harrison, MT from 14 JUN 10 to 18 JUN 10. Contractor is responsible for all travel and per diem to Fort Harrison, MT. Contractor will propose a firm fixed price to provide the Fire Inspector I course on-site at Fort Harrison, MT. The course must be designed to meet or exceed the elements of NFPA 1031, chapter 4 and will provide the tools necessary to obtain certification through NPQS (Pro Board). Instruction will be provided through classroom lectures, group activities and task-oriented applications.

Contractor will provide 40 hours of instruction with a minimum of one (1) licensed instructor, all student texts and training materials and administer certification exam. Contractor is responsible for issuing certification certificates with the NPQB seal for each student upon successful completion of course.

The government will provide adequate classroom and examination facilities, verify student pre-requisites and AFC certification.

Funds are not presently available for this acquisition. No contract award will be made until appropriated funds are made available

B. Anticipated award will consist of five Contract Line Item Numbers (CLINs):

- a. CLIN 0001 will consists of a firm, fixed price for the fire fighter inspector training

The Government will award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate offers: Price and Technical Capability. If products from offerors are found to be technically equivalent, price will be the determining factor.
