**PROJECT TITLE AND NO.: Repair Damaged Perimeter Fence III, JKSE 201100262**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Remove and replace damaged section of fencing, to include, resetting posts and replacing chain-link mesh. Also, include additional fencing to the north, to include up to 1000 linear feet. To meet the requirement for Class A fencing, all posts will require an additional 1' of post be welded to the top of each existing and that a 7' chain-link mesh be reinstalled. Also, the existing 45 degree outrigger with three strands of barbed wire needs to be replaced with a Y-style outrigger holding three strands of barbed wire on each side. Reset posts with eroded bases as required. The Work consists of furnishing all supervision, plant, labor, equipment, appliances, materials and incidentals performing all Work in strict accordance with the Specifications and Drawings.

**MAGNITUDE OF PROJECT:** Less than \$25,000

Please arrive at least 15 minutes early so that you can be escorted on base. This will be the **ONLY** site visit. Information provided at this site visit as well as answers to questions shall not change/qualify the terms and conditions of the solicitation and specifications. Terms remain unchanged unless the solicitation is amended in writing. If an amendment is issued, normal procedures relating to the acknowledgment and receipt of solicitation amendments shall apply.
