

Commander's Critical Information Requirements

Level 1:

- 1. Death or serious life threatening injury to any Montana National Guard Soldier, Airmen, DMA employee, other service member training in Montana.**
- 2. Any deployed Montana National Guard service member killed in action (KIA).**
- 3. Class A or B military aircraft accidents of Montana National Guard or other unit aircraft training in state.**
- 4. Any catastrophic (or predicted) natural or manmade event within Montana with the potential of causing significant damage or loss of life.**
- 5. Whenever the 83rd CST or QRF is tasked to conduct a mission.**

6. Increase if force protection level or intelligence of threats or incidents affecting the security of the Montana National Guard.

Level 2:

- 1. Serious life-threatening injury, requiring hospitalization of any Montana National Guard member or DMA employee.**
- 2. Any deployed Montana National Guard member wounded in action (WIA).**
- 3. Any deployed active duty Montana resident killed in action (KIA).**
- 4. Serious injury, requiring hospitalization of any military member undergoing mobilization or training at Fort Harrison, Gore Hill or other National Guard military sites.**
- 5. Suicide attempt of any Montana National Guard member, DMA employee or other service member training in Montana.**

- 6. Serious accidents, damage, or crimes that will adversely affect Fort Harrison, Gore Hill, or other Montana National Guard facilities or their surrounding communities.**
- 7. Loss of any sensitive or high dollar value item.**
- 8. Alert, mobilization order or special tasking for Montana National Guard units or personnel from higher headquarters.**
- 9. Suspicious activity or other indicators of a possible threat or incident affecting the security of Fort Harrison, Gore Hill, or other Montana National Guard Facilities.**
- 10. Incident involving weapons or ammunition.**
- 11. Reportable fuel, oil, or chemical spills.**
- 12. Incidents involving officers or senior noncommissioned officers.**

13. Military vehicle accidents resulting in high dollar property or vehicle damage.

14. Range fires that threaten government property or the surrounding civilian people, facilities, or property.

15. Sexual assaults against service member, assigned and/or on temporary duty to Fort Harrison, Gore Hill, or other Montana National Guard Facilities.

16. Any incident having the potential for immediate adverse publicity or negative consequences on the Montana National Guard.
