- C. An exception list clearly disclosing any requirements the proposer cannot fulfill.
- D. A proposed time schedule for completed delivery of all items.

Contract financing (advance payment) is not authorized for this contract. Contractor will be paid once completion and acceptance of work has occurred.

The deadline for submitting quotes is 1:00 P.M., Mountain Standard Time, 10 SEP 10. Offers must be received on time to be considered responsive.
